President's Message from Ann McNulty

I am delighted that announce that a Nimble Fingers' mini-group has stepped forward to take the lead on creating a new raffle quilt. This is an important part of putting on a quilt show for next year. It is a key money raiser for the guild, and a way to advertise the guild.

The Razzle-Dazzle Group has a plan, bought fabric and will be handing out blocks for guild members to take at the March meeting. The quilt will be a "one-block-wonder" or a kaleidoscope quilt where fabric is cut into identical triangles that are arranged to form hexagons. Kim Jalette offered to order the raffle tickets

Each person taking fabric will be able to determine which kaleidoscope arrangement of the triangles looks best. The sewing is straightforward, and instructions will be provided. I believe the plan is to ask for the blocks back at the April meeting.

This is but one part of putting on a quilt show, and I will be asking for volunteers to help get the plans for the next quilt show going. We have a contract on a space for the dates Thursday April 30 (setup) through Saturday May 2. This is an important part of funding the guild...think about raising your hand when asked!

How are your panel projects coming? I am so excited about the challenge...and hope you are too. Last year's was a lot of fun, and we will have some WONDERFUL prizes...for everyone who participates and of course for the People's Choice winners. June will be here before you know it!

A Board meeting will take place directly after the meeting. Given that several of the board members are taking the afternoon workshop, I am asking them to get their lunches and work through the lunch time. We want to make this a quick meeting and allow those who are taking the workshop to get there on time.
